Currently MAP Labor Attorneys represent members for:

- Critical Incidents: 24-hour response.
- Contract Negotiations
- Administrative Discipline Hearings and Investigations
- Grievance Arbitration
- Termination Hearings
- Consultation and monitoring of on-duty related civil suits

MAP has expanded the legal defense coverage to include:

- **ON-Duty Criminal Defense Assistance Plan**

MAP will offer assistance to officers who are criminally charged with an offense that occurred within the scope and in the performance of the member's official law enforcement duties. We understand the importance of obtaining a qualified and experienced criminal defense attorney you can trust. Therefore, MAP will reimburse the legal fees for the attorney of your choice. MAP will reimburse member's qualifying legal fees based on the following:

- Misdemeanor charge: Up to \$2500
 - Felony class 3 and 4: Up to \$10,000
 - Felony class 1 and 2: Up to \$15,000
 - Felony class X and above: Up to \$25,000.
- Map will provide comparable amounts for corresponding Federal charges



Licensing Decertification Representation

This coverage extends our current administrative legal defense coverage to the State's new Law Enforcement Review Panel and the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board decertification authority. This includes actions by sworn officers on and off duty. MAP has a dedicated team of attorneys who will represent our members through all phases of the decertification process. This includes:

- Automatic Licensing Decertification
Ex: Allegations of Obstruction, Domestic Battery
- Discretionary Decertification
Ex: Allegations of Unprofessional conduct, untruthfulness, any suspension over 10 days.
- Emergency Decertification proceedings.
Ex: Arrested or indicted for a felony offense.

The MAP Decertification Team attorneys will represent members during the investigations, Review Panel hearings, and final determination proceedings before the Training Board. Hearings on these matters are scheduled to be heard in Cook and Sangamon Counties only.
